NOTICE OF RACE

Organizing Authority

The Phuket King's Cup regatta IOM Class will be organized by the organizing committee of the [Phuket King's Cup Regatta](#) under the auspices of the Royal Varuna Yacht Club in conjunction with the Yacht Racing Association of Thailand, the Royal Thai Navy, the Province of Phuket, Thailand RC Sailboat and the International One Meter Class Association (IOMICA).

1. Rules

1.1 The event will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing 2017-2020. RRS Appendix E will apply.

1.2 The following documents will also govern the 2019 Sattahip international regatta Thailand IOM Class:

Equipment Rules of Sailing

Heat Management System (HMS)

1.3 The Jury may publish a document setting out an accelerated procedure for protests and requests for redress.

2. Eligibility

2.1 .The competition is open to International One Meter class boats.

3. Entry

3.1 Entry form can be filled at registration on December 4th.

3.2 In order that a disabled competitor may be able to compete on equal terms, the race committee shall make as fair an arrangement as possible. Disabled competitors who require any form of help or special requirements shall contact the secretary at ["081-833-2533"](tel:081-833-2533) prior to entry to confirm that suitable arrangements can be made. It is the competitor's responsibility to determine that adequate facilities are available before entering the event.

3.3 The maximum number of entries shall be 36.

4. Measurement and Registration

4.1 Boats together with their measurement certificates shall be presented for registration and equipment inspection.



4.2 No boat shall be eligible to race until it has been registered and has passed equipment inspection.

5. Fees

5.1 The fee for the event per boat is **4,000 THB** (4 lunches and 4 dinners are included)

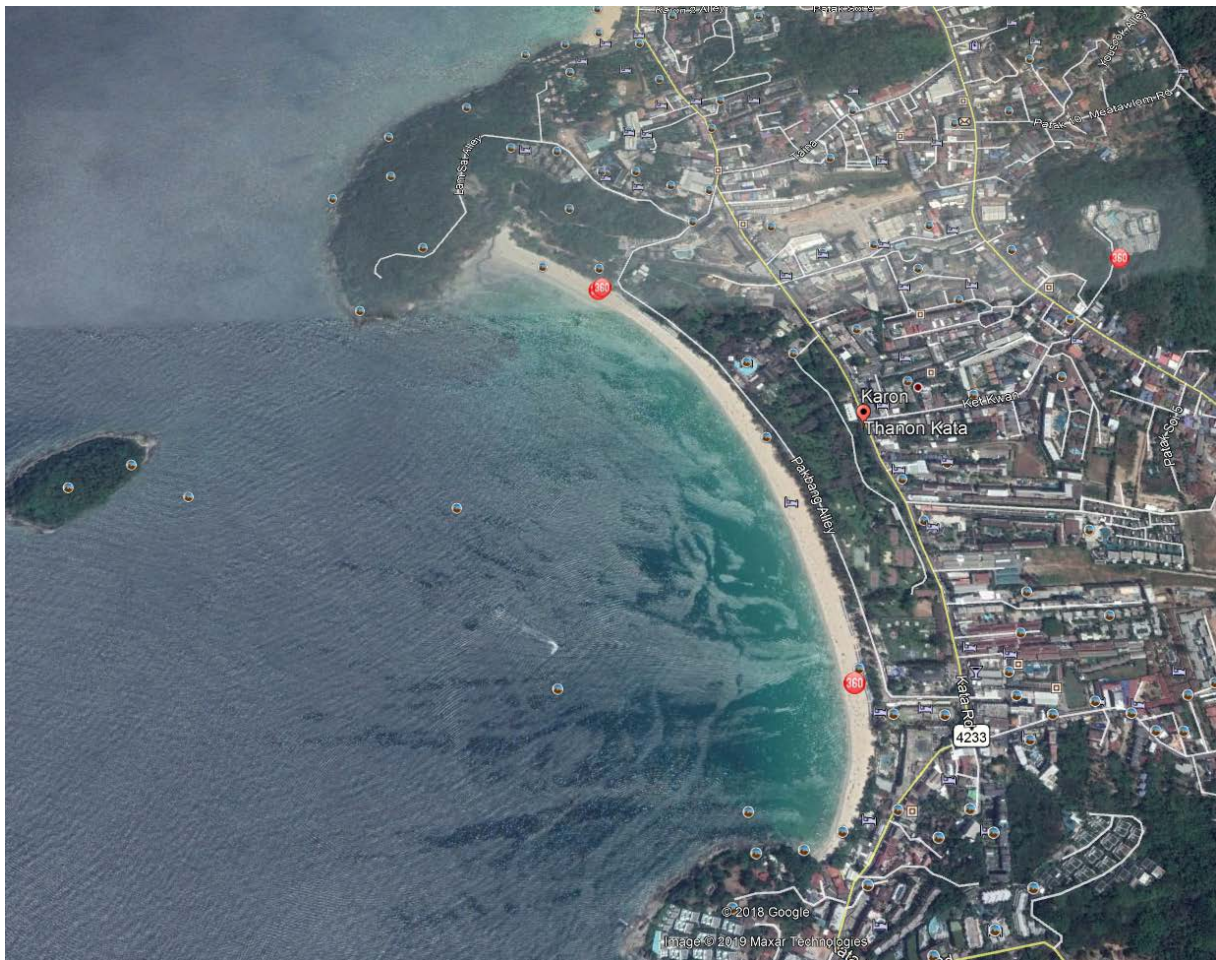
-Dress code for awarding ceremony :
