



Phuket King's Cup Regatta

International Dinghy Classes Race

1th– 7th December 2019

NOTICE OF RACE

1. ORGANIZING AUTHORITY

The Phuket King's Cup Regatta Dinghy Race will be organized by the organizing committee of the Phuket King's Cup Regatta under the auspices of the Royal Varuna Yacht Club in conjunction with the Yacht Racing Association of Thailand, the Royal Thai Navy and the Province of Phuket.

2. RULES

- 2.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing.
- 2.2 No national authority prescriptions will apply.
- 2.3 RRS 40 and the preamble to Part 4 are changed as follows:
 - 2.3.1 The first sentence of RRS 40 is deleted and replaced by: "Each competitor shall wear a personal flotation device (PFD), properly secured at all times while on the water except when temporarily adding or removing clothing."
 - 2.3.2 Add to the preamble of Part 4, after 'racing': "...except rule 40 as amended by NoR 2.3.1".
- 2.4 In all rules governing this championship, both "athlete" and "competitor" mean a person competing in the event. The term "support person" means any person as defined in RRS.
- 2.5 In all rules governing this championship:

[DP] denotes a rule for which the penalty is at the discretion of the international jury.

[SP] denotes a rule for which a standard penalty may be applied by the Race Committee or Technical Committee without a hearing or a discretionary penalty applied by the International Jury with a hearing. This changes RRS A5.

[NP] denotes a rule that shall not be grounds for protests by a boat. This changes RRS 60.1 (a).
- 2.6 If there is a conflict between languages the English text will take precedence.

3. ADVERTISING

Boats may be required to display advertising supplied by the organizing authority.

4. EVENTS

Laser 4.7 (Mixed) born in 2002 or later

5. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY FEES

5.1 The regatta is opened to all sailors from any nations.

5.2 The entry fee is:

Optimist and laser 4.7: 1,500 THB
Laser Standard, Radial: 2,000 THB
420 : 3,000 THB

7. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Sailing Instructions will be available at Registration.

8. VENUE

The event will be held at Kata Bay. Briefing will be done at Kata Bay in front of Club Med Hotel.

9. COURSES

The course will be Olympic Trapezoid courses.

10. PENALTY SYSTEM

10.1 RRS Appendix P, Immediate Penalties for Breaking Rule 42, will apply.

10.2 Decisions of the international jury will be final as provided in rule 70.5.

11. SCORING

- 11.1 The Low Point System of RRS Appendix will apply.
- 11.2 Three races are required to be completed to constitute a regatta.
- 11.3 (a) When 5 races or fewer have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores
- (b) When from 6 to 9 races have been completed, a boat's score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.
- (c) When from 10 or more races have been completed, a boat's score will be the total of her scores excluding two of her worst score.

12. RADIO COMMUNICATIONS

Except in an emergency, a boat that is racing shall not make voice or data transmissions and shall not receive voice or data communication that is not available to all boats. [DP]

13. PRIZES AND COMMENDATION

The following prizes will be awarded for each event:

First Prize (Royal Award Ceremony)

- Optimist Overall 1st - 10th
- Optimist Girl 1st - 3rd
- Optimist under 12 (born 2008 and after) 1st - 3rd
- Laser 4.7 Overall 1st - 3rd
- Laser Radial Overall 1st - 3rd
- Laser Standard Overall 1st - 3rd
- 420 Overall 1st - 3rd

The organising authority reserves the right to award the prize to an event that the number of boats is too small.

14. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the competition entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death in conjunction with or prior to, during or after the regatta.

15. INSURANCE

Each participating boat should be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum coverage of Baht 100,000 or the equivalent.
