



Phuket King's Cup Regatta

NOTICE OF RACE

1. ORGANIZING AUTHORITY

The Phuket King's Cup Regatta Dinghy Race will be organized by the organizing committee of the Phuket King's Cup Regatta in conjunction with the Yacht Racing Association of Thailand, the Royal Thai Navy and the Province of Phuket.

2. RULES

- 2.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing.
- 2.2 No national authority prescriptions will apply.

- 2.3 In all rules governing this championship:

[SP] denotes a rule for which a standard penalty may be applied by the Race Committee or Technical Committee without a hearing or a discretionary penalty applied by the International Jury with a hearing. This changes RRS A5.

[NP] denotes a rule that shall not be grounds for protests by a boat. This changes RRS 60.1 (a).

- 2.4 If there is a conflict between languages the English text will take precedence.

3. ADVERTISING

Boats may be required to display advertising supplied by the organizing authority.

5. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY FEES

- 5.1 The regatta is opened to all sailors from any nations.
- 5.2 The entry fee is:
 - 1,000 THB per sailor.
 - 500 THB per support person.

- 6.2 The event will consist of 10 races. The racing days are scheduled as below:

7. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Sailing Instructions will be available at Registration.

8. VENUE

The event will be held at Karon Bay. Briefing will be done at Karon Bay in front of Karoncity Office.

9. COURSES

The course will be Olympic Trapezoid courses.

10. PENALTY SYSTEM

- 10.1 RRS Appendix P, Immediate Penalties for Breaking Rule 42, will apply.
- 10.2 Decisions of the international jury will be final as provided in RRS 70.5.

11. SCORING

- 11.1 The Low Point System of RRS Appendix will apply.
- 11.2 2 races are required to be completed to constitute a regatta.
- 11.3 (a) When 5 races or fewer have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores
- (b) When more than 6 races have been completed, a boat's score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

12. [DP] RADIO COMMUNICATIONS

Except in an emergency, a boat that is racing shall not make voice or data transmissions and shall not receive voice or data communication that is not available

to all boats.

13. PRIZES AND COMMENDATION

The following prizes will be awarded for each class:

Optimist Overall 1st – 5th (First Prize Royal Award Ceremony)

Optimist under 12 Boy (Born in 2012 or later) 1st - 3rd

Optimist under 12 Girl (Born in 2012 or later) 1st - 3rd

Optimist under 10 Overall 1st - 3rd (Born in 2014 or later)

Open Skif Overall 1st – 3rd (First Prize Royal Award Ceremony)

Monohull dinghy class (handicap) Overall 1st - 3rd (First Prize Royal Award Ceremony)

The organizing authority reserves the right to award the prize to an event that the number of boats is too small.

14. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the competition entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death in conjunction with or prior to, during or after the regatta.

15. INSURANCE

15.1 A competitor is advised to have personal accident and health insurance that cover him while attending the event and while racing.

15.2 The organizing authority is not responsible for verifying the status or validity of any insurance certificate.

15.3 To the fullest extent permitted by law, each competitor agrees to indemnify and hold Host, Owners, affiliates, officer, employees, agents, members, volunteers, committee persons and race officials, acting in their official capacities, harmless from any claim arising from competitor's acts or omissions.
